5. Emerging themes

Chris emailed an initial analysis of key themes as follows

<u>Like:</u> friendly village community – good amenities – countryside with easy access to towns - train

<u>Don't like:</u> Insufficient infrastructure – not enough doctors – not enough buses/public transport – queues at level crossing

<u>Like to see:</u> Wool in Bloom – more doctors/another surgery – green spaces/with seating – by-pass or bridge over crossing

<u>Don't want to see:</u> second homes – houses without infrastructure/development sympathetic to area – loss of fields/green spaces
