My wife and I own a house in Andover Green, Bovington

Until May 2019 I was the Vice Chair of Wool Parish Council, I was also Chair of the Planning Committee and a member of the Finance and Policy Committee

I am employed by Dorset HealthCare University NHS Foundation Trust as it's Data Protection Officer and Information Governance Manager

I am Chair of Trustees for Wool Village Hall (The D'Urberville Centre) and Chair of the Hall Management Committee

I am Chair of The Royal British Legion Bovington Branch

I am a Committee Member of 1st The Queen's Dragoon Guards Regimental Comrades Association (Chair of the Wessex Branch)

Shareholder in Bovington Residents Company Ltd a company made up of residents who own their houses in Andover Green and Cranesmoor Close, Bovington. This is a private estate of former MoD properties sold to the public. The residents manage the upkeep of the estate infrastructure and amenities. I was the Chair of the Board of Directors for 5 years

I have lived in the Parish since 2002

I led a Parish Council working group which authored a paper in response to the initial Purbeck District Council consultation on Housing and suggested that Wool could potentially take up to 500 houses. I believe that sensible planning linked with infrastructure development in a phased agreed approach to develop housing to match a housing need will be required. However, the housing should be affordable and aimed at supporting those families wanting to work and raise families in Purbeck and not be for second home use or used as a commuter belt for other areas

I do not live near any of the proposed development areas, however, I understand the concerns of the Parish
