WHAT HAPPENS NEXT

The Steering Group will use your feedback to develop a Neighbourhood Plan (NP).

The NP will address the issues you have highlighted and ensure what you like remains in place across the Parish.

Wool Parish Council wants an NP in place as soon as possible so the Steering Group will focus on'quick wins' in light of the proposed developments. There will be revisions of the plan in future years to address the remaining issues.

The Steering Group will continue to communicate whilst the plan is under development and you may be asked for your opinions again.

Once the NP has been developed, you will be able to vote on it in a referendum. If more than 50% of voters approve the NP will become a legal document which must be followed by developers and anyone building property.

Issues you have raised that cannot be addressed in the NP will be passed onto the relevant bodies for action.

KEY THEMES ABOUT

- Good range of facilities like schools, post office and library
- Like the fact that we have doctor, dentist and chemist
- Capacity of Wellbridge Practice coping with increased demand from development population
- Like The D'Urberville, parks, fields, playgrounds and good pubs
- Good mix of local shops
- Would like a bank
- Not enough bins
- Would like the library to be open longer
- Would like better facilities in Bovington
- Would like improved sports facilities like gym, exercise equipment, skate park
- Concerns about need and impact on infrastructure
- Would like public toilets

KEY THEMES ABOUT

- Overwhelmingly against increasing the size of the Parish
- Second homes are not wanted
- Houses should not be built too close together
- Purbeck Gate design is not sympathetic to the rest of Wool
- Houses need to be eco-friendly
- Houses should be built with brick not poor quality coloured render
- Purbeck Gate build is of poor quality and not adopted by council
- Any development must consider impact upon the environment
- Want truly affordable housing for locals
- Houses should have fewer rooms
 and fewer storeys
